


## Central Serous Chorioretinopathy | OcuLight® SLx

**Patient:** A 35-year-old male teacher presented with CSC in both eyes. The CSC was extrafoveal in his right eye, and subfoveal in his left. Both eyes had decreased color vision; and he experienced metamorphopsia in his left eye.

## **MicroPulse Treatment Parameters**

Laser | Wavelength: OcuLight SLx | 810 nm

Spot Size on SLA: 125 μm Contact Lens: Mainster Focal

Power: 950 mW Duration: 300 ms Duty Cycle: 5%

Evidence of Laser Treatment on FA: None

**Physician Technique:** Applied 1121 (OD) and 1191 (OS) high density (confluent) treatment applications to cover the affected area, including over the fovea in the left eye. There is no visibile laser endpoint during treatment. Rely on objective post-treatment outcome measures, i.e. VA, OCT, FA.
